Eligibility

- Be a resident of Weld County
- Have earned a cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Be pursuing an agricultural career
- Be planning to attend an accredited college, junior college or trade school in the fall as a freshman or sophomore
- The Gene and Sharon Inloes Scholarship requires a livestock-related college major

Application

Submit the following documents by mail in one packet:

- Completed application form (see page 2)
- An essay that addresses the student's goals and how the applicant's relationship to agriculture, achievements, or experiences have shaped their lives and prepared them to achieve said goals.
The essay should not exceed two pages, 12-pt. font, double spaced.
- A resumé that includes work, school, and community activities
- Official copy of academic transcript (*H.S. and college, if appropriate*)
- Two letters of reference
- Scholarship winners may be asked to supply a picture to be used with public announcements.
